## ONE WEEK five camps

### FAMILY CAMP

Family Camp mingles the generations for spiritual renewal and fellowship with rich teaching morning and evening. Traditional hymn-sings and contemporary music are lifted up in praise and worship in the 108 year old open-air Nixon Tabernacle.

### CHILDREN'S CAMP

The Children's Program runs simultaneously alongside Family Camp, for toddlers through elementary school. Services and activities are offered during morning and evening worship, and special family activities each afternoon.

### YOUTH CAMP

Youth Camp is a week long residential camp for grades 7-12. Experience instruction in practical Christianity, music worship, small groups, recreation, and fellowship with other youth who share Christian values.

### TWEEN CAMP

New this year, our Tween Camp is aimed at offering 5th and 6th graders a taste of residential camp. The 3-day, 2-night (Thursday-Saturday) experience gives tweens a space to learn about Jesus, fellowship and worship with their age group. Times of praise and recreation might be combined with Youth Camp.

### GRADE 13 CAMP

Grade 13 is open to young adults post high school to 24 yrs old. In a group tenting environment, all will have an opportunity to develop devotion and gifts in the body of Christ, make some friends and enjoy worship and recreation.

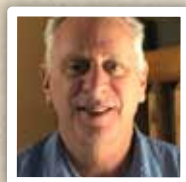
### TABERNACLE

### YOUTH

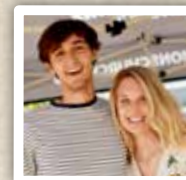
#### LEO ROBINSON

### CHILDREN

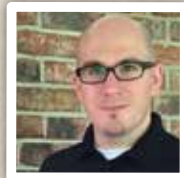
#### STEVE & JANET RAE BURN
